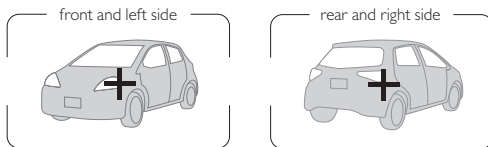


# VEHICLE PHOTO REPORT INSTRUCTIONS

Which photographs must be presented following conclusion of the CASCO insurance contract?

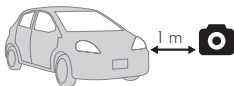
## 1. All photographs of the vehicle, which show the licence plate number and:

- front and left side;
- rear and right side.



**Important!** Make sure to provide proper quality photographs with clearly visible car make and licence plate number, where the vehicle is not covered by other objects and without sunlight glares and shadows, etc. If the photograph shows unauthorised persons or objects, such as another vehicle with a licence plate number, the data of the vehicle or natural person not related to the insurance contract must be blackened before saving the photos or sending them to a company representative.

## 2. Photographs of damages clearly depicting the affected vehicle parts.



**Important!** Make photographs of the damages from different angles from a distance no higher than 1 m from the vehicle.

## 3. Photograph of the vehicle's VIN (if not available – the chassis number) showing the part of the vehicle that allows to identify the vehicle.

## 4. Photograph of the dashboard of the vehicle with a running engine, which clearly depicts the mileage information.

## 5. Additional photographs, if not parts are not visible in other photographs:

- all glass windows of the vehicle – front, rear, side and roof window (if any);
- vehicle's licence plate number.
